The primary mission of this program is to start building the foundation to produce good sailors who can sail and race safely along the Coast of Maine. This foundation is built on two basic criteria:

We are committed to building this foundation in a safe and fun program. In this program all junior sailors are encouraged to contribute and are respected as members of a team. Please take a few minutes to review our program ground rules and code of conduct and discuss them with your sailor. If you have any questions, please contact Program Coordinator. We need this form signed and returned to us by the start of the program. A copy of this form will be posted at the club.

GROUND RULES

- Life jackets worn at all times on the docks and in the boats
- No running on the docks
- No throwing anyone in the water
- Only instructors can operate the whalers
- Shoes worn on the boats should not make black scuffmarks
- No swearing or crude language; no drugs or alcohol
- Swimming is only allowed in the designated area under the supervision of an instructor.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- We will treat each other fairly.
- We will help each other whenever necessary.
- We will try to solve disagreements by talking it over ourselves. If we cannot, we will ask the instructors to help.
- We will take the highest care of the boats, floats, supplies and physical property as if
- They were our own.
- We will sail safely at all times.

DISCIPLINARY actions for conduct not in accordance with the goals of the program will be the sole discretion of the Sailing Program Director including **NON REFUNDABLE EXPULSION**.
